Dragon Boats Support “Summer Hunger” in the Triangle

Raleigh, No. Carolina. (Apr. 9, 2013) — Individuals and teams from throughout the Triangle region will converge on June 22nd at Lake Wheeler to compete in the Stop Summer Hunger Triangle Dragon Boat Festival, benefitting the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina.

It is anticipated that up to 30 teams from local, corporate and community groups will be present at Lake Wheeler Park to partake in this fun community event and to raise dollars and awareness for the Stop Summer Hunger campaign at the Food Bank. Linda Fisher, Manager of Food Drives and Special Events at the Food Bank said "It's a privilege to promote an event that brings the community together and gives back to such a great cause." Fisher also added "We're very excited to bring awareness to the issue of summer hunger facing so many of our youth through this sport."

Dragon Boat Racing is great fun for anyone, young or old. Most local events attract primarily mixed teams from corporations, public service groups, clubs sponsored by small businesses, high schools, colleges and universities. There are now over 70 communities hosting Dragon Boat Festivals in the U.S. alone, and over 60 million participants worldwide.

Entering your own dragon boat team in the races is easy. Paddles, life vests, boats, and steerspersons will be provided as well as a one training session in advance of the event. Each team just has to provide 20 paddlers, a minimum of 8 must be female, and a drummer. On race day each team will race in three heats on a 350m course.

The Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina is a nonprofit organization that has provided food for people at risk of hunger in 34 counties in central and eastern North Carolina for more than 30 years. The Food Bank serves a network of more than 800 partner agencies such as soup kitchens, food pantries, shelters, and programs for children and adults through warehouses in Durham, Greenville, New Bern, Raleigh, the Sandhills (Southern Pines), and Wilmington. In fiscal year 2011-2012, the Food Bank distributed nearly 45 million pounds of food and non-food essentials through these agencies.
